Conditions of entry

Eligibility

1. For the purpose of the Sculpture by the Bay Small Sculpture Prize, sculpture is defined as **freestanding**, non-site specific, original, one of a kind, three-dimensional object. **Only freestanding works will be accepted for selection.**
2. Entries must not exceed 40cmW x 40cmD x 50cmH and must have a stable base.
3. All entries must be the original work of the submitting artist and designed or completed within two years prior to 1 March 2019. The artist must be 16+ at 30 June 2018.
4. The work must not have been awarded a prize in any other exhibition.
5. Only one work, or three pieces that form one work and remain within the dimensions and sold as one work, will be accepted per artist entry.

6. A non-refundable entry fee of \$30 (incl GST) must be paid by Direct Deposit to the Sculpture by the Bay bank account at the time of entry submission.
7. Artists are to provide an ABN **OR** ATO Statement by Supplier Form and tick the Hobby Artist box on the form.
8. Sculpture by the Bay reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Prize and exhibition, in which case entry fees will be refunded within 30 days.
9. All exhibiting artists must participate in the volunteer roster during the exhibition period.

Judging process

1. There will be one round of judging to take place on Friday 1 March 2019 between 12.30pm and 3.30pm. No exhibiting artists are to be present.
2. Judges will decide the Sculpture by the Bay Small Sculpture Prize and the Special Commendation prize. These prizes will be announced at the opening of the exhibition on Friday 1 March 2019 at 6pm. The judges decision is final.

Exhibition criteria and process

1. Works selected for the exhibition must be delivered on Friday 1 March 2019 after 9am and before 12 noon and collected on Monday 4 March 2019 after 2pm and before 4pm.

2. Works selected must be available for the full exhibition period of Saturday 2 to Monday 4 March 2019.

3. Artists selected for exhibition are responsible for the transport of their work to and from the exhibition space. This includes freight and transport costs in both directions. Artists selected for exhibition must have provided two print quality images of their final work and an artist statement by 1 February 2019.

4. All works exhibited in the Sculpture by the Bay Small Sculpture Prize will be for sale. Sculpture by the Bay will deduct a commission of 20% from the sale price of any works sold through the exhibition. **The sale price listed on the entry form will remain as the final sale price on all promotional material.**

5. All care will be taken when displaying the works however Sculpture by the Bay and Christian Fletcher Gallery will not be responsible for loss, theft or damage. Artists are responsible for the shipping and insurance cover of their artworks.

6. The placement of all finalists' works within the exhibition will be at the discretion of the appointed curator.

7. Artists grant Sculpture by the Bay the right to reproduce their work and biographical material by any means in any media for archival and promotional purposes. The artist will be properly acknowledged in such material.

8. Works that are not collected by 4pm Monday 4 March 2019 will become the property of Sculpture by the Bay, unless arrangements have been negotiated and agreed in writing, without any liability to Sculpture by the Bay. After this date the works may be used or disposed of as determined by Sculpture by the Bay.

9. Payment of awards and sold works will be by Direct Deposit to artists within 30 days from 4 March 2019.

- ⇒ ATO Statement by Supplier form if applicable;
- ⇒ 2 print quality images of final work submitted by 1 February 2019.
